### Concept Note

For Urban October our UN76 Dialogue is in observance of World Cities Day and will address this year's theme of "Better City, Better Life: Adapting Cities for Climate Resilience." While strengthening our resilience to build back stronger following the global pandemic, cities and communities are suffering the effects of climaterelated disasters, such as floods, droughts, sea level rise, heatwaves, landslides and storms. Many inhabitants are expected to be affected by coastal flooding and the one billion people in urban informal settlements are particularly at risk. Creating the need for more innovative and sustainable, climate-resilient solutions addressing a range of issues including poverty reduction, ensuring basic services and livelihoods, the provision of accessible, affordable and adequate housing, investing in infrastructure and smart cities while upgrading informal settlements and managing ecosystems. Successful, well-governed cities greatly reduce climate-related risks for their populations. Recently, UN Secretary-General Antonio Guterres, released his "Our Common Agenda" Report for the UN76th General Assembly where he spoke of the urgency in addressing these rapidly growing issues and importance of being inclusive while investing in innovative solutions. We can see it is vitally important that we continue our focus on the SDGs and the UN2030 Sustainable Development Agenda to build partnerships with Member States, UN-Habitat, national and local authorities, as well as stakeholders from civil society and the private sector to be better prepared to achieve inclusive, safe, resilient and healthier cities for the future we need - to "Leave No One Behind."
